Drop-off: Art pieces should be delivered to Mystic Blue Signs *Wed /Thurs Sept 30/Oct 1*. If you are unable to deliver your work to Mystic Blue on those two days, we can make arrangements for you to drop it off with someone who can. The show will be installed on Friday Oct 2 and taken down on Sat Nov 7.

After the show, work must be picked up by the artist within one week unless other arrangements have been made with Mystic Blue.

Identification: Each piece must be accompanied by the information form at the bottom of this page. Multiples for sale need only **one** form for identical pieces.

Note: We will accept work *For Sale* or *Not For Sale*. The Center for the Lettering Arts takes a gallery commission of 30% on original works and 50% on reproductions, but we are happy to show work that is not for sale.
